A request was made for support for a Toucan crossing outside Doddington Hall to help residents, visitors and staff.

- The cycle path has increased use and parkrun will be starting in 2020. Both need a safe location to cross.
- Lincolnshire County Council will do a road survey in the spring.
- Numbers of people crossing have been estimated by Doddington Hall from till receipts.
- A more accurate traffic count is needed outside the church
- People counts will be needed indicating age estimates to indicate numbers of children or more elderly pedestrians crossing
- Both the traffic count and pedestrian counts can be arranged by Giant Bike Store

The roadside speed indicator needs repair but will be able to provide data again.
