Cllr Thompson had sent his apologies and sent in the following report:

County Council Meeting 17th February 2023

Council agreed a tax rise of 4.99% in total (this includes a 2% rise for adult care). Lincolnshire will still have one of the lowest council tax rates in the country. Despite the rise in council tax, and additional government funding, the council will still need to use a further £7.5m from its reserves to balance the books, based on current projections. The final budget included the addition of £8.7m to the development fund. The money for this will be drawn from the council's reserves, and it will be used for projects that benefit local communities. There was also an additional £7m for road maintenance, meaning the highways budget for 2023/24 has now risen to around £93m. The budget also includes:

- £275m for adult care and community wellbeing
- £84m for children's social care
- £22m for Lincolnshire Fire & Rescue

Cllr Overton reported that:

- a proposal to reconsider the reduction of PCSO's had been submitted.
- NKDC were not suggesting any budget cuts. They had accumulated funds through the New Homes bonus.
